- **Declutter before moving:** Donate, sell, recycle, or dispose of items you no longer need.
- **Pack non-fragile items yourself:** If appropriate, handling some packing tasks can reduce labor requirements.
- **Move during flexible dates:** Ask whether rates vary according to the day or time of the move.
- **Prepare the property:** Keep hallways and pathways clear so movers can work efficiently.
- **Disassemble suitable furniture:** If you can safely do so, preparing certain pieces ahead of time may reduce labor.
- **Request a detailed estimate:** Understanding what is included helps prevent unexpected expenses.

Most importantly, compare companies based on overall value. A reliable moving company with transparent pricing, professional handling practices, and clear communication can be more economical than a provider that advertises a low rate but adds numerous charges later.
