

Mediation Planning

Mediation planning helps you become a strategic mediator. We were introduced to the concept of the strategic mediator by Forrest Mosten at his May 2004 advanced family mediation training. Mosten is also quick to credit Christopher Moore's *The Mediation Process* (Wiley/Jossey Bass 2003) and Michael Lang and Allison Taylor's *The Making of a Mediator*, (Jossey Bass 2000) with these ideas and we've summarized them here before telling you what we're doing in our own practice.

A strategic mediator approaches each mediation as follows:

- Develop a theory;
- Develop a goal for the case (in most cases, the goal is an agreement);
- Develop a strategy to get to the goal (you may do this individually for each issue);
- Develop an intervention based on the strategy;
- Reflect on what went well and what the mediator could have done; differently after the parties are gone.

Each strategy may have many possible interventions, but it's good to have a few thought out beforehand.
