Note: The specific values are identified by the game's internal RNG and can differ from one platform to another. The above figures are representative of the most popular version (5×5 grid).

Possibility of striking a mine is straightforward: it equals the number of mines divided by the overall variety of cells. For a 5×5 grid with 3 mines, the chance of a single click landing on a mine is $3/25=12\%$.
