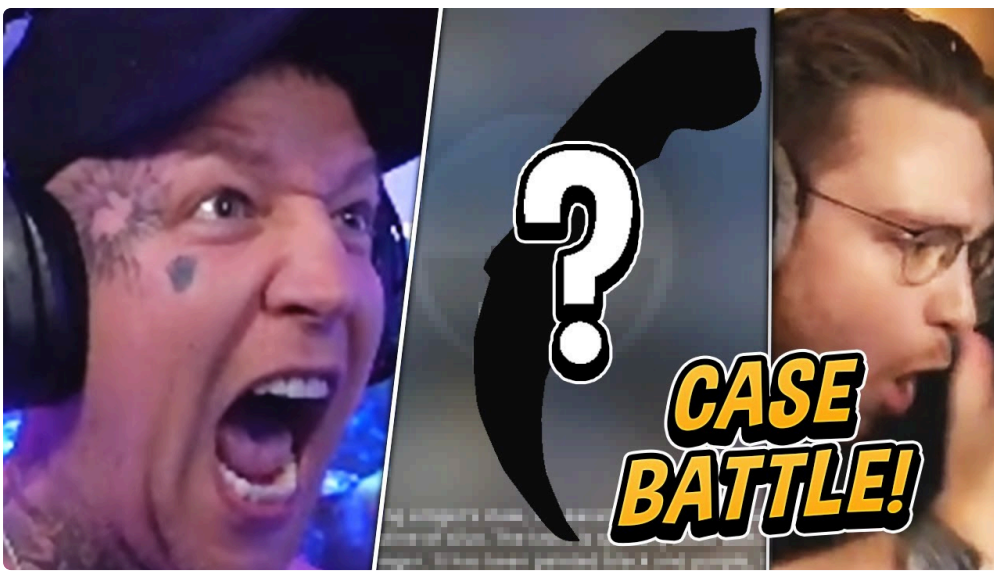
1. **Validate Platform Reputation**-- Look for user reviews, certifying info, and whether the website releases provably reasonable algorithms.
