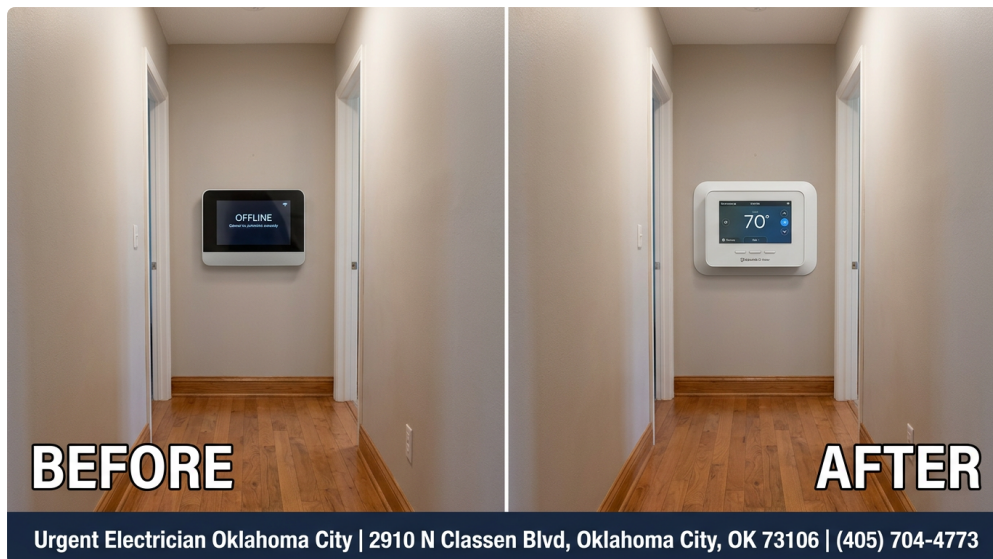
Understanding Callback Risk in Emergency Situations?
