Why Consider a 115V Mini Split for a Bedroom?

Mini splits powered by 115V circuits are often overlooked because most HVAC equipment runs on 208-230V. However, 115V mini splits have some distinct advantages:

- **No Need to Upgrade Electrical Panel:** Most residential panels supply ample 15A 110-120V circuits, simplifying installation.

That said, availability is limited, so not every brand offers a true plug-and-play 115V model designed to run quietly in a bedroom setting.



Key Focus: Bedroom Mini Split Noise Levels

Noise is measured in decibels (dB). For bedrooms, quieter is better—ideally below 30 dB on low or “quiet mode” settings to avoid sleep disturbance. Some mini splits advertise down to 18 dB, which is whisper-quiet and nearly imperceptible.

Which Brand Offers the Quietest Bedroom Mini Split?

Zone Air: The 18 dB Champion

Zone Air's **ZA115Q** indoor handler hits an exceptionally quiet **18 dB in quiet mode**, making it an excellent choice if silence is your highest priority. The unit comes with a **pre-charged Quick Connect line set**, a game changer for DIY enthusiasts or homeowners wanting a straightforward install without hiring a licensed refrigerant technician.

Keep in mind: while the line set is pre-charged for a sealed refrigerant loop, the outdoor condenser unit still requires proper mounting and electrical connections to a **dedicated 15A circuit with a pigtail plug cable** containing three wires (power, neutral, ground). This 15A circuit requirement is non-negotiable because running the mini split on an undersized breaker or extension cords is a common but dangerous DIY mistake that can cause nuisance tripping or even fire hazards.

Cooper & Hunter: The Smart, Quiet Option

Cooper & Hunter's **CH-S12FVQI** scores around **21 dB on quiet mode**—still very quiet for bedroom use. It includes Wi-Fi control, which can be convenient but slightly increases low-end noise due to added fan controls. It also comes with a **pigtail plug cable rated for at least 15A**, meaning it's designed for proper wiring to a standard household circuit.



This brand's warranty terms are solid but require strict adherence to registration within 30 days of purchase to maintain full coverage. Unfortunately, some buyers overlook that critical step, which is a pet peeve of mine because it reduces long-term peace of mind.

MrCool: DIY-Friendly and Quiet

MrCool is known for making one of the most DIY-friendly mini splits on the market. Their **DIY 12k BTU 115V** system has a noise rating near **19 dB at lowest fan speed** and includes a pre-charged Quick Connect line set like Zone Air. This means no expensive refrigerant evacuation or recharge tools are needed.

One unvarnished truth: While MrCool markets this unit as truly "plug-and-play," it still requires a **dedicated 15A breaker and proper wiring with the correct pigtail cable with three conductors** to meet electrical code—a detail often underemphasized in marketing materials.

Why Dedicated Circuits and Proper Wiring Matter

A recurring issue I see is homeowners running HVAC mini splits on extension cords or shared circuits. This is a safety hazard and often voids warranties. The **dedicated 15A circuit** and the use of a reliable **pigtail plug cable** rated for at least 15 amps and containing three wires (power, neutral, ground) are mandatory.

Extension cords often can't handle the inrush current of HVAC compressors and fans, risking heat buildup or fire. Skipping these electrical steps might save \$\$ upfront but costs more in repairs and replacement down the line.

DIY Installation with Pre-Charged Quick Connect Line Sets

Traditionally, mini splits demand professional HVAC refrigerant line brazing and evacuation. Luckily, brands like Zone Air and MrCool now offer **pre-charged Quick Connect line sets** that make refrigerant handling a non-issue for homeowners with moderate DIY skills. - **Reduced Complexity:** No refrigerant handling license needed.

However, even with simplified lines, the outdoor unit must be properly grounded and connected to a **dedicated 15A breaker** via a pigtail plug cable with power, neutral, and ground wires—don't skip this step.

Quiet operation and DIY installation are fantastic, but if the warranty terms are complicated or restrictive, the overall value falters. For example:

- **Zone Air** offers a 5-year compressor warranty but requires registration within 30 days.
- **Cooper & Hunter** provides a 7-year warranty only if you register the product promptly and use certified installers.
- **MrCool's DIY line** has a 5-year warranty with registration and adherence to installation guidelines.

Missing the registration window or ignoring electrical code can void your warranty and leave you on the hook for costly repairs or premature replacement—definitely no small matter.
