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If you own a home in Arlington, you already know what our environment does to exterior surface areas. One damp spring and a shaded side of your house can start growing algae. A couple of seasons of pollen and traffic dust will turn a bright driveway dull gray. Brick steps get slick. Composite decks gather mildew in the grain.



The instinct is right: call a professional for Power Washing Arlington VA before you invest a weekend battling a rental maker. The challenging part is picking the right contractor. Power washing and pressure washing can either bring back and secure your residential or commercial property or silently damage siding, gouge concrete, and force water where it ought to never go.



I have actually walked more than one homeowner through repairs that were required just since a "cheap" pressure wash removed stain off a deck or blew water behind old siding. The damage is not always instant, however it is constantly more pricey than hiring someone skilled in the first place.

Power Washing vs Pressure Washing: Why the Distinction Matters

Vegetation matters too. Numerous power washing services are technically "biodegradable," however that does not imply your shrubs will delight in a direct hit of focused chemical. Plants can be pre-wet, gently covered, and rinsed again after treatment. On hot days, that extra care can be the distinction between healthy landscaping and curled brown leaves 2 days later.

For siding, a normal safe technique around Arlington is a low-pressure application of a moderate algaecide or bleach-based solution, mild brushing if needed, then wash from top down with low pressure. The water stream must not be forced up under horizontal laps or into weep holes around windows.

On decks, I prefer to spend more time on chemical dwell and lighter pressure, even if it implies going a bit slower. Wood fibers that have been raised by aggressive washing never ever quite look the exact same, and you feel the roughness underfoot long after the deck dries.

If the business seems happy with using "maximum power" all over, deal with that as a caution, not a selling point.
