### What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live online gambling establishment video game show hosted by an enthusiastic, real-life speaker. The game is broadcasted from a cutting edge studio geared up with lively, colorful sets that evoke a carnival or tv video game reveal environment.

The centerpiece of the video game is an enormous, vertically mounted wheel consisting of 54 sections. Gamers place bets on where they think the wheel will stop after a spin. ### Understanding the Wheel Segments and Bets

To play Crazy Time successfully, gamers need to initially understand the betting design. The 54 sectors on the wheel are divided into number bets and benefit video game bets. Each section offers various payment potentials and probabilities.

#### Number Bets

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel. Payout: 1:1
- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel. Payment: 2:1
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel. Payment: 5:1
- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Payment: 10:1

#### Reward Game Bets

- **Coin Flip:** Appears 4 times on the wheel.

- **Money Hunt:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Pachinko:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Crazy Time:** Appears 1 time on the wheel.

## The Top Slot Feature

Before every single spin of the main wheel, a small two-reel slots situated above the main wheel spins simultaneously.

- **How it Works:** The left reel shows one of the betting options (numbers or bonus offer video games), while the right reel shows a multiplier (ranging from 2x up to 50x).
- **The Result:** If the symbol on the left reel matches the result of the primary wheel spin, the multiplier is used to that win. If it indicates a perk game, the multiplier uses to all multipliers inside that specific reward round.

## Diving Into the Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The real magic of the video game happens when the wheel lands on among the 4 bonus offer segments. Players who have actually positioned a bet on that specific benefit round are transported to a secondary game screen, where huge multipliers wait for.

### 1. Coin Flip

The most basic of the four perk rounds. A coin with a red side and a blue side is turned by a device. Before the flip, random multipliers are designated to both sides of the coin. Whichever side lands deal with up figures out the player's payout.

- **Bonus offer feature:** If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can sometimes be set off, providing gamers another chance at higher rewards.

### 2. Cash Hunt

Players are provided with an enormous interactive screen displaying a shooting gallery with 108 random multipliers hidden behind different symbols (like a cactus, target, or constable's badge).

- **The Gameplay:** Players use a virtual cannon to intend and contend one symbol before a countdown timer expires. Once the timer ends, all symbols expose their concealed multipliers, and the gamer is awarded the multiplier they strike.

### 3. Pachinko

Inspired by the standard Japanese arcade game, Pachinko includes a large wall filled with physical pegs.

- **The Gameplay:** The live host drops a puck from the top of the wall. As the puck cascades downward, it bounces arbitrarily off the pegs before landing in one of a number of multiplier zones at the bottom. If the puck arrive at a "DOUBLE" zone, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped again.

### 4. Crazy Time

The ultimate bonus offer round. Gamers stroll through a red door into a surreal, virtual world featuring a massive, 64-segment mega wheel.



- **The Gameplay:** The player (or the host, depending on the video game variation) selects among three flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel is spun, and whatever multiplier the selected flapper points to is awarded. Like Pachinko, this wheel also features "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" segments, enabling fortunate players to trigger huge wins up to the video game's cap of 20,000 x.

## Tips and Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is fundamentally a video game of opportunity determined by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and physical physics, players typically use different methods to handle their bankroll and take full advantage of home entertainment.

- **The Conservative Approach (Number Betting):**
  - Focus mainly on wagering numbers 1 and 2, that make up a large portion of the wheel. This method yields regular, smaller sized wins, keeping the bankroll stable and extending playtime.
- **The Balanced Approach (Covering Bonuses):**
  - Spread little bets across all 4 reward rounds while occasionally backing number 10. This makes sure eligibility for the high-paying reward video games without draining pipes funds too rapidly.
- **The High-Volatility Approach (Bonus Hunting):**
  - Place bets solely on the bonus rounds (Cash Hunt, Pachinko, Crazy Time, Coin Flip). This design needs persistence and a bigger bankroll, as droughts can happen, however it provides direct access to the game's highest possible payouts.

## Best Practices for Responsible Gaming

1. **Set a Budget:** Decide on a repaired total up to invest before beginning the game and never ever chase losses.
2. **Understand the RTP:** Keep in mind that bonus offer bets normally have a slightly lower RTP than basic number bets, suggesting they are greater threat, greater benefit.
