



You can live with a squeaky door, a jagged photo structure, a cumbersome ice manufacturer. You can not deal with roaches in the cooking area, bed pests in the head board, or woodworker ants in the sill plate. Experience by pest type matters more than years in organization. A more recent pest control contractor that deals with bed pests regular usually outshines a big exterminator company that sends out a generalist two times a year. Ask, "The number of bed insect tasks have you completed this year? What is your re-treatment rate? What are the usual causes when they fall short?"
