Advanced players know that a 6:5 blackjack table is a sucker's bet. They specifically hunt for 3:2 tables, ideally where the dealership bases on a soft 17 (S17) and late surrender is allowed.

- **Accounting for Side Bet Variance:** Side bets like *21 +3*, *Perfect Pairs*, and *Bust It* deal high payments, but they also come with a disastrous house edge (often varying from 4% to over 13%).
