



If you have resided in Alexandria for more than a few periods, you currently know the city's plumbing has personality. Brick rowhouses hide cast iron stacks. Mid-century cattle ranch homes socialize copper, galvanized steel, and the occasional secret PVC. Basements flirt with the water level after a hard rain. Include mature tree origins and the clay soil along the Potomac, and you get a perfect recipe for slow-moving drains, repeating obstructions, and backed-up drains.
