

Rideshare Accident Claims in Midland TX A rideshare crash in Midland can involve more insurance policies than an ordinary wreck, and sorting out which one pays first is often the hardest part. The Uber or Lyft driver may carry a personal auto policy. The rideshare company carries its own coverage, and whether it applies can depend on whether the app was on, whether a trip had been accepted and whether a passenger was in the car. If another driver caused the crash, that driver's insurer comes into play too. Your own policy, including any uninsured or underinsured motorist coverage you did not reject in writing, may also matter. Passengers are often in a strong position, because they rarely share any blame for the crash. Still, a passenger hurt on Loop 250 north or on the way home from Midland International Air and Space Port can find that three adjusters each point at someone else. Other drivers hit by a rideshare vehicle face a similar puzzle. Texas is an at-fault state, so the question of who caused the crash drives everything, and the driver's app status at that exact moment can change which company answers the claim. Pedestrians and cyclists struck in downtown Midland or along Big Spring Street run into the same tangle of coverage.

Evidence in these cases fades quickly, so start saving it right away. Take screenshots in the app showing the trip, the driver's name, the vehicle, the route and the time stamps. Save the receipt emails. Photograph the vehicles, the intersection and your injuries. Get names and phone numbers from witnesses. If you were taken to Midland Memorial Hospital, keep every discharge paper and bill. Don't delete the app or your ride history, and don't sign anything an insurer sends until someone you trust has reviewed it. If you were hurt, missed work or the other driver's insurer is disputing fault, a lawyer usually pays for themselves. Texas gives you two years from the crash to file most injury lawsuits, but waiting that long is risky.
