In a downtown loft with concrete floors and metallic windows, the proprietors wished the kitchen to behave like a part of the residing vicinity. We used a thin porcelain slab with a soft limestone print, mitered to read as a two-inch side. The backsplash ran complete top, outlets moved to the underside of the higher cabinets, and the island had no overhang at the window side, so it learn like a monolith other than a bar. When you sat at the settee, the counters contemplated simply adequate gentle to boost the room without pulling focal point from the paintings wall.

A domestic abode with three tuition-age youth and a serious cook needed durability specifically. Perimeter counters went to leathered black granite. The island changed into Taj Mahal quartzite in a honed finish, which paired with white oak cabinets and helped bridge the warm-cool gap between the dwelling room rug and the immaculate diversity. We deliberate seam placement after templating, aligning the faint quartzite veins with the cabinet rails. Three years later, the surfaces still seem contemporary, and the occasional nick on the granite area buffs out with a diamond pad.

Budget, significance, and in which to spend
