In a downtown loft with concrete floors and metal home windows, the owners wanted the kitchen to behave like a part of the residing facet. We used a skinny porcelain slab with a smooth limestone print, mitered to read as a two-inch facet. The backsplash ran complete peak, outlets moved to the underside of the upper cabinets, and the island had no overhang at the window area, so it study like a monolith as opposed to a bar. When you sat on the settee, the counters mirrored simply sufficient gentle to boost the room without pulling consciousness from the paintings wall.

A loved ones residence with three faculty-age youth and a severe cook dinner obligatory durability above all. Perimeter counters went to leathered black granite. The island changed into Taj Mahal quartzite in a honed end, which paired with white oak shelves and helped bridge the warm-cool hole between the living room rug and the stainless fluctuate. We deliberate seam placement after templating, aligning the faint quartzite veins with the cupboard rails. Three years later, the surfaces nevertheless appearance sparkling, and the occasional nick on the granite edge buffs out with a diamond pad.

Budget, price, and wherein to spend

Open plans elevate the magnitude of the counter as a visible funding, yet that doesn't mean overspending on each and every floor.
