- **Money Hunt:** Appears 2 times. A shooting gallery screen with 108 random multipliers hidden behind signs. Players goal and shoot to reveal their reward.
- **Pachinko:** Appears 2 times. A glowing wall filled with pegs. A puck is dropped, and anywhere it lands determines the final multiplier.
- **Crazy Time:** Appears only 1 time. The supreme perk round. Gamers go into a massive virtual world with a giant wheel including three flappers. Selecting a flapper can yield multipliers as much as 20,000 x.
