Understanding the Wheel Segments and Bets

To play Crazy Time efficiently, gamers must initially comprehend the betting design. The 54 sections on the wheel are divided into number bets and bonus offer game bets. Each section uses different payment capacities and probabilities.



Number Bets

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel. Payout: 1:1
- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel. Payment: 2:1
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel. Payment: 5:1

- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Payment: 10:1

Benefit Game Bets

- **Coin Flip:** Appears 4 times on the wheel.
- **Money Hunt:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Pachinko:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Crazy Time:** Appears 1 time on the wheel.

The Top Slot Feature

Before every spin of the main wheel, a small two-reel slots situated above the primary wheel spins all at once.

- **How it Works:** The left reel shows among the wagering options (numbers or reward games), while the best reel shows a multiplier (ranging from 2x as much as 50x).
- **The Result:** If the sign on the left reel matches the outcome of the main wheel spin, the multiplier is applied to that win. If it points to a reward video game, the multiplier uses to all multipliers inside that particular reward round.

1. Coin Flip

2. Cash Hunt

Gamers are provided with an enormous interactive screen showing a shooting gallery with 108 random multipliers concealed behind numerous symbols (like a cactus, target, or constable's badge).

- **The Gameplay:** Players use a virtual cannon to aim and contend one symbol before a countdown timer expires. When the timer ends, all symbols reveal their concealed multipliers, and the player is awarded the multiplier they hit.

3. Pachinko

Motivated by the standard Japanese arcade game, Pachinko features a large wall filled with physical pegs.

- **The Gameplay:** The live host drops a puck from the top of the wall. As the puck waterfalls downward, it bounces randomly off the pegs before landing in one of several multiplier zones at the bottom. If the puck arrive at a "DOUBLE" zone, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped again.

4. Crazy Time

- **The Balanced Approach (Covering Bonuses):**
 - Spread small bets across all four bonus offer rounds while sometimes backing number 10. This guarantees eligibility for the high-paying benefit video games without draining funds too quickly.
- **The High-Volatility Approach (Bonus Hunting):**
 - Place bets solely on the reward rounds (Cash Hunt, Pachinko, Crazy Time, Coin Flip). This style needs patience and a larger bankroll, as dry spells can happen, but it uses direct access to the video game's greatest possible payouts.
