Metal fences call for a diverse system. 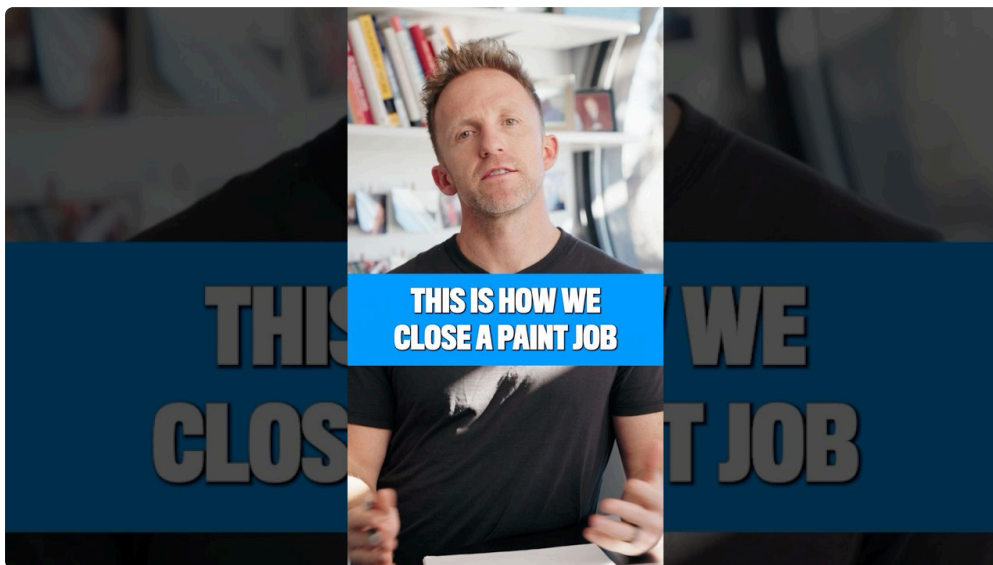

We sprayed and lower back-brushed each and every board facet to forestall photograph framing. The color held properly by using excessive summers. At year 3, the south facing sections confirmed a moderate flatting of sheen yet no peel, exactly as deliberate.

Choosing shades that age gracefully

Color alternative is individual, however how a shade a while is technical. Light hues chalk greater subtly and hide mud and complicated water spots from sprinklers. Mid-tones like heat grey or sage make landscapes pop without soaking up too much warmth.
