Managed WordPress hosts have matured, however no longer all are equal. We self-hosted two subsetting font records and switched to font-show change with preconnect and preload. Hosting moved to a tuned PHP eight.2 stack with Redis and Brotli, and we put HTML at the brink for anonymous clients.

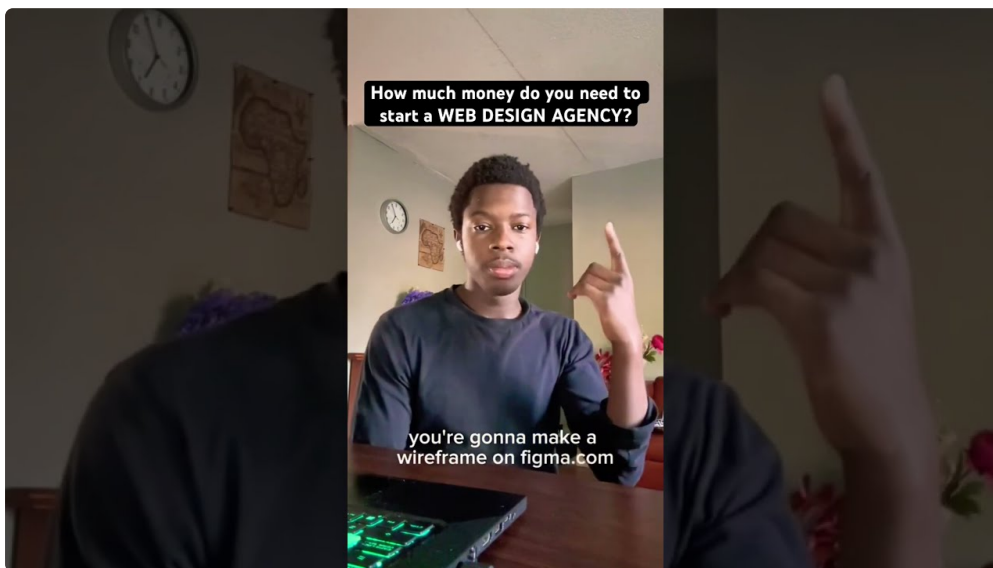
