

Garage Door Repair Services in Los Angeles

A garage that faces afternoon sun may experience more rapid breakdown of its weather seal and bottom seal than a shaded installation.

Springs offset the weight of the door. A **torsion spring** is mounted above the door and rotates as the door moves, while an **extension spring** stretches along the horizontal tracks. Both types can wear out after repeated cycles. Signs of failure include a loud snap, a visible gap in the spring, a door that feels extremely heavy, or a door that rises only a few inches.

Garage Door Spring Cost and Typical Repair Pricing
