

Whiplash and Soft Tissue Injury Claims in San Antonio Whiplash has a reputation problem. People joke about it. Insurance adjusters roll their eyes at it. But if you've ever tried to turn your head to check a blind spot on Loop 1604 a week after being rear-ended, you know it's no joke. Neck pain, stiff shoulders, headaches and trouble sleeping can hang around for weeks or longer. Whiplash and other soft tissue injuries happen when the head and neck snap forward and back, straining muscles, ligaments and tendons. They're common in rear-end crashes, the kind that happen every day in stop-and-go traffic on I-10 near Huebner Road or along Blanco Road at rush hour. Following too closely and texting behind the wheel are two big causes. The tricky part is timing. Adrenaline can mask pain at the scene, and symptoms often show up hours or even a day or two later. Many people tell the officer they're fine and then wake up the next morning barely able to move. Soft tissue damage can also show up as back pain, dizziness, or numbness and tingling in the arms. That delay is exactly what insurers use against you. Because soft tissue injuries don't always show up on an X-ray, adjusters may argue you weren't really hurt, or that something else caused the pain. Your strongest tool is a clear record. Get checked the same day or as soon as symptoms appear. Follow your treatment plan, whether that's physical therapy, chiropractic care or specialist visits. Keep a simple daily note of your pain, what you couldn't do and the work you missed. Gaps in treatment are one of the first things an insurer points to.

Most Texas car accident lawyers work on contingency, so their fee is a percentage of what they recover and nothing if they lose. Check everyone for injuries, call 911 and get the report number from SAPD or the Bexar County Sheriff's Office. Take photos of the vehicles and the scene, get witness details and see a doctor quickly, even if you feel fine. Then call The Aguirre Law Firm, PLLC at (210) 922-0808, which is open 24 hours a day. Can I recover compensation if I was partially at fault? Yes, in many cases. Texas uses modified comparative fault, so you can still recover as long as you are less than 51 percent responsible, although your award is reduced by your share of the blame. Insurers often push extra fault onto injured drivers after crashes at busy spots like Loop 1604 and I-

10, and the firm works to challenge that with evidence. Should I talk to the other driver's insurance company? It's best not to give a recorded statement before you get legal advice. Adjusters can use casual comments like "I'm fine" to argue your injuries aren't serious. Alex Aguirre knows these tactics from his years on the defense side, and his team can handle insurer calls for you from the first day. How long do I have to file a car accident claim in Texas? Texas generally gives you two years from the date of the crash to file a personal injury lawsuit, and two years from the date of death for a wrongful death claim. Some claims, such as those involving a government vehicle, can have earlier notice requirements. Calling The Aguirre Law Firm, PLLC early gives the team time to gather evidence before it disappears. You may be able to recover current and future medical costs, lost wages and earning capacity, property damage, pain and suffering, mental anguish and physical impairment. What if the driver who hit me has no insurance? Your own policy may still protect you. Texas insurers must offer uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage and personal injury protection, and PIP is included unless you rejected it in writing.
