1. The AWP|Dragon Lore

Initially dropped solely on specific maps like Cobblestone throughout significant tournaments, these memento bundles are now extremely uncommon. A Factory New Souvenir Dragon Lore signed by super star gamer Skaddoodle famously cost over £ 60,000 years back, and prices have actually just escalated given that.

2. The AK-47|Case Hardened (Pattern 661 "Blue Gem")

While a basic Case Hardened AK-47 is reasonably cost effective, the top-tier pattern indices-- particularly Pattern 661-- cover practically the whole leading receiver of the weapon in a pristine, reflective blue.
