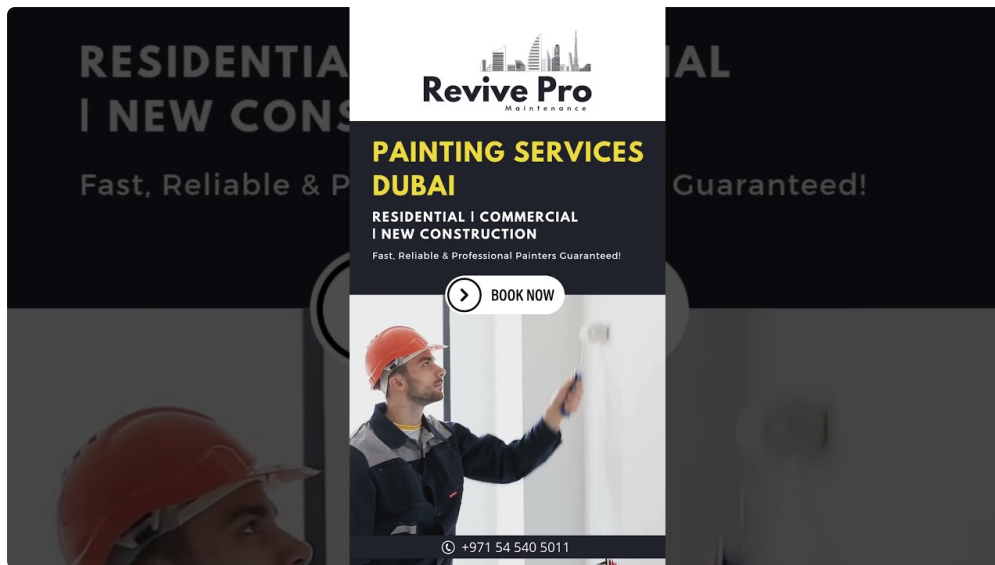

We checked moisture at questionable trim - readings hovered at 12 to fourteen p.c after a dry spell - then primed with a tannin-blocking off acrylic on sanded cedar. We to come back-brushed two coats of a satin acrylic at the body and used a reasonably scale back sheen at the crown particulars to save glare down underneath the afternoon sunlight.

The homeowner informed me later that the exceptional payment spent turned into now not the paint manufacturer but the time budgeted for caulking and spot-priming at elevation. Four years on, a quick visit for hurricane touch-u.s.a.showed tight joints and constant sheen, precisely what you want to determine on a tall outdoors.
