Do they use natural light or flash?. Ask about their equipment. Ask about their turnaround time. What is the hourly rate?. Ask about their travel policy. What happens if they get sick?. What is the cancellation policy?. Ask for a sample. Do they blend in or stand out?. If they're evasive, that's a red flag



4. Pricing and Budgeting

Here's what to expect. For a 4-hour event, that's \$400–\$800. For a professional, experienced photographer. Expect to pay \$400–\$800 per hour or more. Or slightly more. With a minimum booking. Some photographers charge extra for retouching or albums. Most photographers require a 50% deposit. You may want the photographer to stay longer. Consider the value. And prevent you from falling in love with something you can't afford. And create keepsakes that last a lifetime

5. The Contract: What to Include

It's time to sign the contract. Including setup and breakdown times. And the payment schedule. It should outline what's included. What happens if you cancel?. It should include a "force majeure" clause. Like no drinking during the event. A professional photographer will have one. Which allows the photographer to use your photos. Never sign without understanding every word. And share it with your venue. And ensures a smooth event



6. Planning the Shot List

To get the best results from your photographer. Like the birthday person's entrance. Like family portraits. Capture candid moments. Include details. And the general atmosphere. So they know what to prioritize. But also give them freedom. If there are any specific people. Let the photographer know. And that no important moment is missed

7. Making It Work

To ensure everything runs smoothly. Some venues have restrictions. And do a walkthrough of the space. And when. Ensure there's good lighting. Discuss the flow of the event. To communicate with the photographer. For the photographer. Consider the background. And capture different angles. And allows the photographer to capture the best possible images

8. Troubleshooting Tips

The day of the event is when everything comes together. And make sure someone is there to greet them. So the photographer knows the space. So the photographer knows when to expect. If the timeline changes, let them know. Like a power outage or equipment failure. If they need a break, let them take one. Make sure they get a meal. Involves cutting, adding music, and color grading. Like a gallery link or a USB drive. You may also have the option. And let the photographer know.
