Force Buy	Purchasing weapons regardless of a low bank to catch the opponent off guard. SMGs (MP9/Mac -10), Deagles, or Scout with no/light armor.	
Complete Buy	Optimal monetary health. Purchasing the finest rifles and complete utility. Rifles (AK-47/ M4A4), full armor/helmet, complete utility, and a Defuse Kit (CT).	

Secret Tactical Elements in CS2

1. The New Smoke Meta

CS2 presented volumetric, dynamic smoke grenades that engage with the environment. Bullets and high-explosive (HE) grenades can temporarily clear sightlines through smoke. Gamers should adapt their execution designs:
