percentage. Rushing primer onto damp siding traps moisture, which tries to escape later, pushing the film off as blisters.

Temperature, dew level, and wind velocity all effect a paint movie. 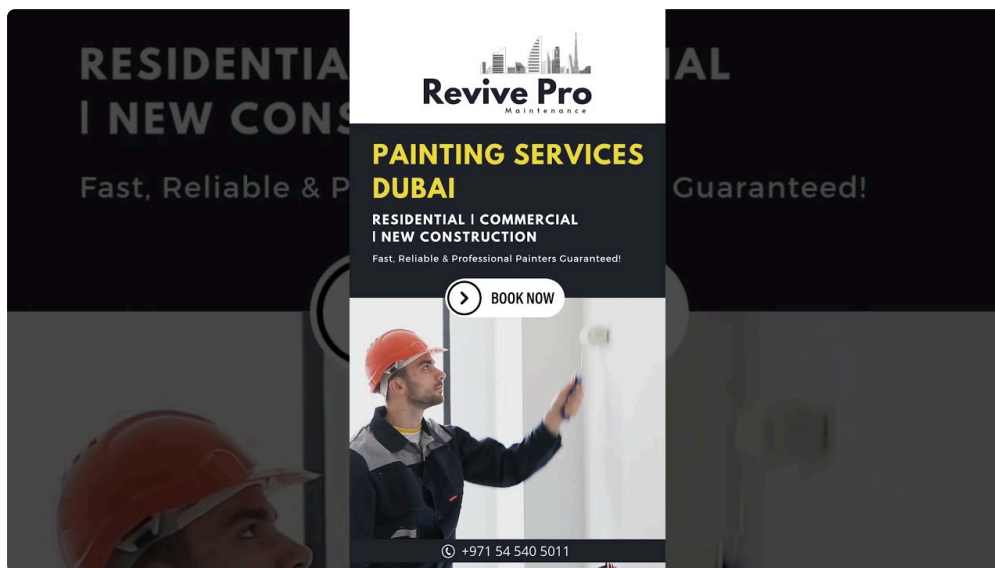
