1. The Martingale Strategy

2. The Reverse Martingale (Paroli)

- **The Risk:** A single crash cleans out accumulated revenues, but restricts the danger to just the initial base bets.

3. The Low Auto-Cashout Grind

- **How it works:** Setting an automated cashout at an extremely low multiplier, such as **1.10 x to 1.20 x**, intending for high-frequency, little wins.
- **The Risk:** While win rates are high, a single 1.00 x crash or a fast succession of low crashes can quickly eliminate lots of small wins.
