An place of business tower desired polished stainless dimensional letters on a tumbler curtain wall. Under brilliant solar, the reflections broke the phrase into shards. We introduced a narrow, non-reflective charcoal backer panel at the back of the letters, set two inches off the glass. The letters still felt top class, yet now the eye had a regular luminance box. Tenants stopped giving directions that integrated "you can actually omit us the primary time."

A store insisted on crimson letters over a mid-tone efficient fascia to suit a holiday crusade. Red on inexperienced compresses contrast for most viewers. We provided two mockups at scale, one with crimson face lit letters over a deeper eco-friendly panel, and one with white letters and a crimson accessory bar. The group selected the white letters. Seasonal accents lived on tradition banners and window vinyl, whilst the storefront indications stored their all-season legibility. The numbers supported the decision.
