Why Does Ignoring Annual Service Lead to Collateral Damage in Your Refrigerant Circuit?

Refrigerant is your system's lifeblood, and low levels—whether from a slow leak or a manufacturing defect—create immediate cascade risk. When refrigerant drops below design specifications, evaporator coil pressure falls. Low pressure triggers suction-line freeze-up, where moisture in the return air line freezes solid on the copper tubing. That ice blockage prevents refrigerant circulation, causing the compressor to run dry. A dry-running compressor has no oil lubrication. Within hours, metal-on-metal friction inside the compressor generates friction heat, and the compressor seizes or floods with acid-contaminated oil. That acid spreads through your entire refrigerant circuit, damaging the expansion valve, the condenser, and any remaining coils.
