

A cracked windshield has a way of turning an ordinary drive into a small expedition. One minute you are rolling toward work, coffee in the cup holder, the next a stone snaps off a truck tire and leaves a bright little starburst in your glass. It sits there in your line of sight like a dare. Keep driving and hope it behaves, or start the hunt for the best windshield replacement near me before that chip grows into a wandering crack across the whole front windshield.

That search can feel like standing at a trailhead with ten paths and no map. Reviews are trail markers, not trophies

A high rating catches the eye first. A 4.9-star rating based on 162 Google reviews is not a throwaway number. It suggests a strong pattern of customer satisfaction, especially when the written comments keep returning to the same themes. In the case of Impex Auto Glass, reviews mention professional service, mobile replacement, fair or affordable pricing, and fast turnaround. But the star rating alone is only the summit photo. The climb matters more. A review that says "great service" is pleasant.
