In a downtown loft with concrete floors and steel home windows, the homeowners desired the kitchen to behave like element of the dwelling discipline. We used a thin porcelain slab with a smooth limestone print, mitered to learn as a two-inch aspect. The backsplash ran full peak, stores moved to the underside of the top shelves, and the island had no overhang at the window part, so it study like a monolith in place of a bar. When you sat at the sofa, the counters mirrored just sufficient light to boost the room with out pulling recognition from the paintings wall.

A loved ones domicile with 3 school-age young people and a severe cook obligatory longevity certainly. Perimeter counters went to leathered black granite. The island turned into Taj Mahal quartzite in a honed end, which paired with white oak shelves and helped bridge the nice and cozy-cool gap between the living room rug and the stainless vary. We deliberate seam placement after templating, aligning the faint quartzite veins with the cupboard rails. Three years later, the surfaces nevertheless appearance clean, and the occasional nick at the granite aspect buffs out with a diamond pad.

Budget, price, and wherein to spend

Open plans increase the value of the counter as a visual investment, but that doesn't mean overspending on each and every surface. If the island dominates, allocate extra budget to a top rate slab there and settle upon a less demanding, rate-advantageous drapery on the sides. Keep your eye on overall square pictures. 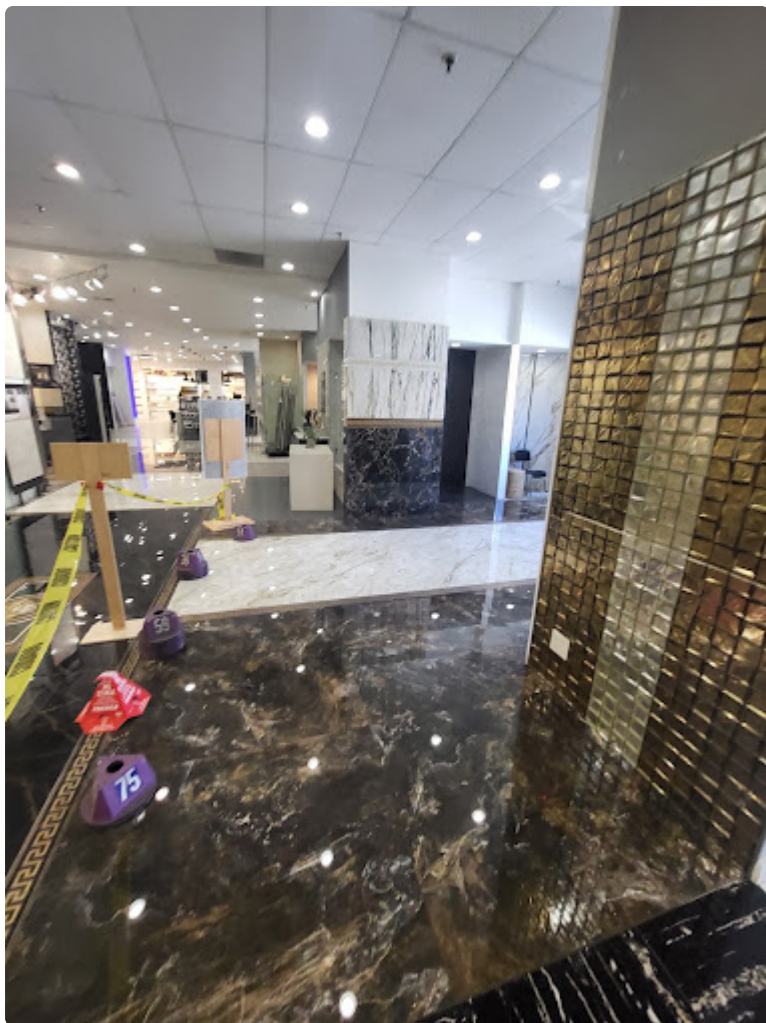
