- **The Goal:** Secure small, consistent wins.
- **The Risk:** While you will win the huge bulk of rounds, a single early crash (1.00 x or 1.05 x) can wipe out the revenues of 10 effective rounds.

2. The Martingale Strategy (Progression Betting)

- **The Strategy:** Double your bet each time you lose, and return to your base bet when you win.
- **The Goal:** Recover all previous losses with a single win plus a profit equivalent to the base bet.
- **The Risk:** This requires an enormous bankroll and can rapidly hit platform maximum bet limits or diminish your funds during a prolonged losing streak.

3. The Reverse Martingale (Paroli System)

- **The Strategy:** Double your bet after every *win*, and go back to the base bet after a loss.
- **The Goal:** Ride a hot streak to take full advantage of profits while lessening risk throughout cold streaks.
- **The Risk:** You must manually squander at a reasonable multiplier (like 2.00 x) regularly for this to work.
