In a downtown loft with concrete floors and metal windows, the owners wished the kitchen to behave like part of the living discipline. We used a skinny porcelain slab with a tender limestone print, mitered to study as a two-inch aspect. The backsplash ran full top, outlets moved to the underside of the upper cabinets, and the island had no overhang at the window aspect, so it examine like a monolith rather than a bar.
