In a Victorian with problematic plaster cornices, the client sought after full-height cupboards to the ceiling. The cornice assorted by way of basically an inch across the room. Removing it would have erased a bit of historical past. We designed a two-section crown on the cupboards, with a small high cap that would flow and be scribed to the plaster. The eye read one continuous line, and the plaster remained intact. The more molding became a small payment to avoid the home's soul.
