- **Verify the case type**-- Ensure you have the proper case for the essential you plan to use.

- **Check the outcome**-- After the animation, see the skin's float value and market value.

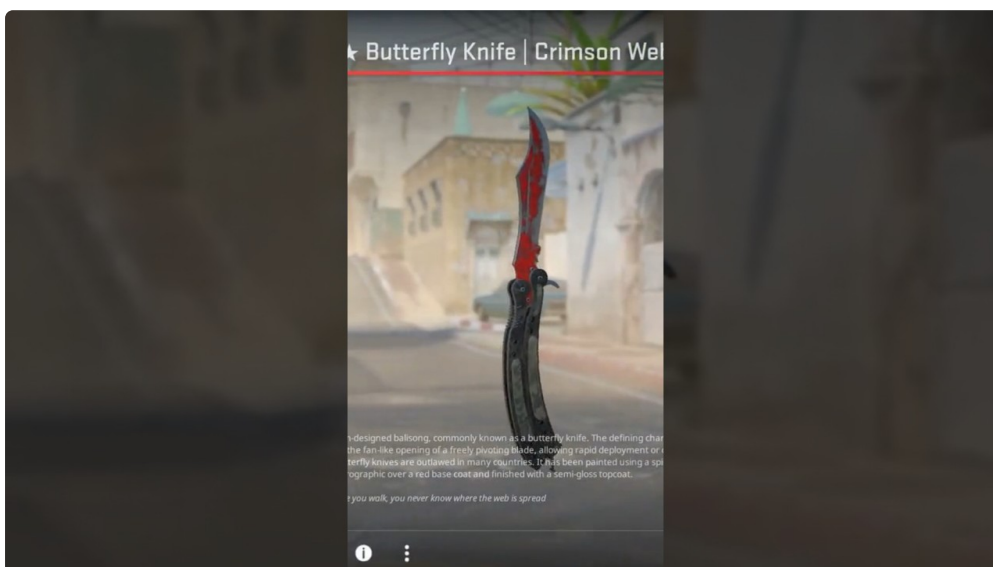
Tips for Responsible and Profitable Case Opening
