March and early April pretty much convey bloodless nights and brief bursts of heat sun. Lawns wake erratically. July and August are survival months. Deep, infrequent watering paired with a increased mowing peak helps turf ride out heat. Mulching at this level returns moisture and colorings the crowns. I will switch to bagging at some stage in a humid week if powdery mould or leaf spot exhibits up in shaded regions alongside mature timber in Cambridge Park. After good thunderstorms that lay the grass over, bagging is usually purifier for a reset.

September and October deliver some of the top-quality mowing of the yr. Cooler nights and steady moisture suggest dense boom. Mulch by way of early fall to recycle vitamins and minerals, then bag as leaf volume raises, in particular below maples on lots close to Gretna Crossing Park. If you intend aeration and overseeding, bag the 1st couple of cuts after seed is usual, then go back to mulching.

Soil, thatch, and the hidden component to the equation
