We sprayed a dedicated adhesion primer, sanded to 320, then sprayed two coats of a waterborne alkyd satin. Doors hung on day four, with bumpers hooked up to avoid sticking. The proprietor waited every week formerly loading shelves. Total time, eight running days with a 4 man or women team, simply over four hundred linear feet of trim, 17 doorways, and 34 cupboard pieces. Three months later, we did a courtesy payment. No blocking off, no sags, and the stairwell looked flat at sundown.
