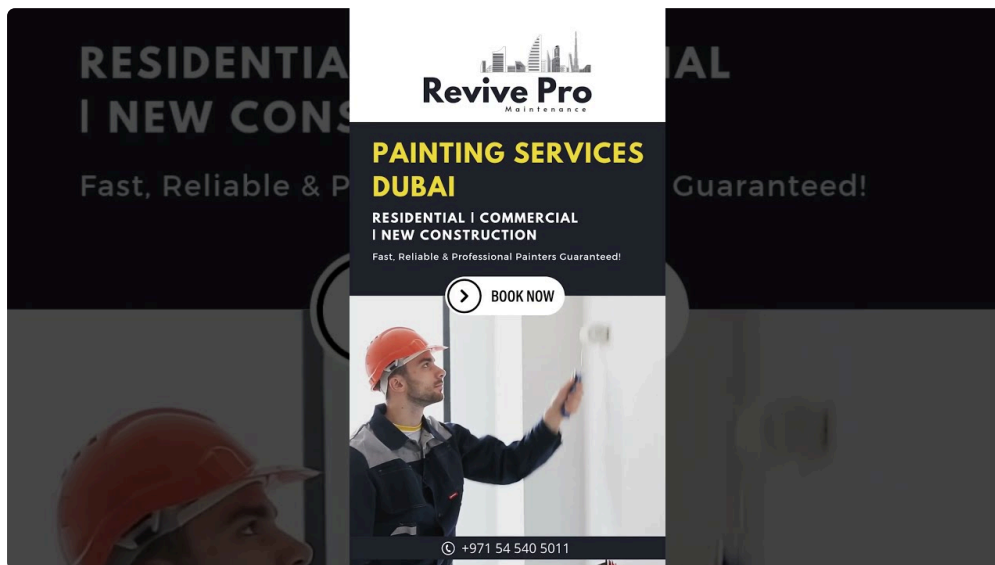

We again-brushed two coats of a satin acrylic at the body and used a just a little cut sheen on the crown facts to prevent glare down beneath the afternoon sun.

The property owner advised me later that the most excellent cash spent was not the paint brand but the time budgeted for caulking and notice-priming at elevation.
