They required a service that pleased code, fit the room, connected right into their alarm, and did not delay procedures for a week. On installation day, the truck gets here with a correctly tagged and shielded dog crate, equipment labeled by elevation, and a prepare for where ladders, lifts, and hand tools will live. 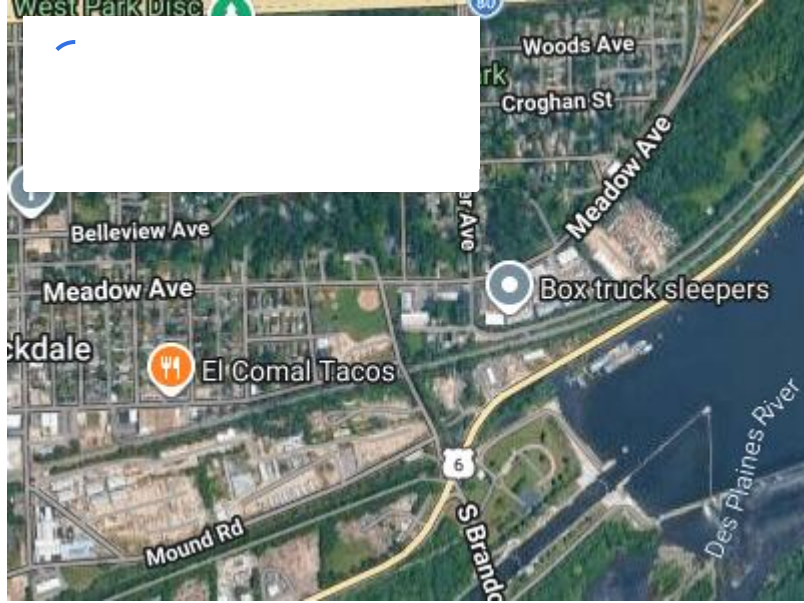
