Understanding the Betting Layout

The Crazy Time wheel is divided into 54 segments. Players can bet on numbers (1, 2, 5, or 10) or on among the 4 interactive reward games. Each sector has a various frequency on the wheel, directly affecting its payment capacity and possibility of landing.

As seen in the table above, the numbers appear more regularly, using consistent, smaller wins, while the bonus offer rounds are rarer but hold the key to the video game's life-altering multipliers.

The Four Wild and Wonderful Bonus Rounds

The primary draw of Crazy Time is unquestionably its four perk functions. When the wheel stops on a bonus sector, players who put a bet on that specific segment are transferred into a secondary video game (either via physical studio sets or immersive CGI environments).

1. Coin Flip

- **Frequency:** 4 segments on the wheel.
- **How it works:** A basic coin with a red side and a blue side is flipped by a device. Each side is appointed a random multiplier before the flip. Whichever color lands face up wins the multiplier for the participating gamers. If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can in some cases be set off for another opportunity.

2. Cash Hunt

- **Frequency:** 2 sections on the wheel.

A countdown timer begins, and players should utilize their cursor (or let the video game auto-shoot) to intend and fire at a sign. When time goes out, the surprise multiplier behind the chosen sign is revealed and used to the player's stake.

3. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 segments on the wheel.
- **How it works:** Inspired by the standard Japanese arcade game, players exist with a big physical wall filled with pegs. The host drops a puck from the top, and it bounces arbitrarily down through the pegs until it lands in among a number of multiplier zones at the bottom. If the puck lands in a "DOUBLE" slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again for massive possible wins.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** 1 segment on the wheel.
- **How it works:** The supreme reward round. The host opens a red door, strolling gamers into a surreal, brilliantly colored virtual wonderland including a massive huge wheel. Players must select one of 3 flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel is spun, and whatever multiplier the selected flapper points to is awarded. Just like Pachinko, landing on "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" increases all the worths on the wheel and sets off a re-spin, approximately an optimum cap of 20,000 x.
